Dock and Freight Elevator Information for Deliveries

Loading Dock- Normal Hours are 6am until 5pm Monday thru Friday

- Dock is accessible via Lower Wacker Drive, just east of the Monroe Street down ramp. This dock location is also known as the P-1 level.
- All persons entering One South Wacker through the dock *must* sign in with Security at the dock office and present a photo ID.
- Unless prior arrangements have been made, all vehicles are expected to off-load, deliver their materials or products, and depart within 30 minutes.
- Storage of any kind on the dock platform is strictly prohibited and any items found in the area will be immediately discarded.
- No parking is allowed in the inner lane of Lower Wacker next to the building. All unattended vehicles will be reported to the Chicago Police Department.
- All contractor personnel entering via the dock *must* access their floor destination via a freight elevator. The same holds true whenever they leave their job floor.

Loading Dock Dimensions:

• Posted height Dock Bay #1 is 11'0", and Dock Bay #2 and #3 is 12'0". The depth of all bays is 50'; bay entrance to dock platform. The width of each bay varies from 9'5" to 10'8". Some bay slots will accompany taller truck trailers. Inquiry can be made to the Dock Security Officer upon the trucks arrival which bay slots have the higher ceiling capacity.

Freight Elevator- Normal Hours are 6am until 5pm Monday thru Friday

- Freight elevator is located down a corridor east of the dock on the P-1 level.
- A Security Officer operates the freight during business hours.
- All requests for use of the freight elevator during non-business hours *must* be approved by the Security Director via Building Engines.

- Weight Capacity is 6700 lbs;
- Doors are 53" W x 100" H;
- Inner Cab Measures 70" W x 103" D x 128" H

Small freight (#22)

- Weight Capacity is 3500 lbs;

- Inner Cab Measures 73" wide X 65" deep X 118 "high
